Role and purpose

Water Industry National Environment Programme (WINEP)*

- WINEP sets out the actions that companies will need to complete to meet their environmental obligations.
- Drivers for investment range from measures for protected areas, improvements to meet River Basin Management objectives and other local environmental priorities
- Technical guidance strongly promotes the use of catchment based approaches.

Water Industry Strategic Environmental Requirements (WISER)

- WISER is a joint EA / NE strategic steer to water companies on the environment, resilience and flood risk for business planning purposes.
- Replaces Defra's 'Statement of Obligations'
- Regulatory expectations include statutory obligations and non-statutory requirements.

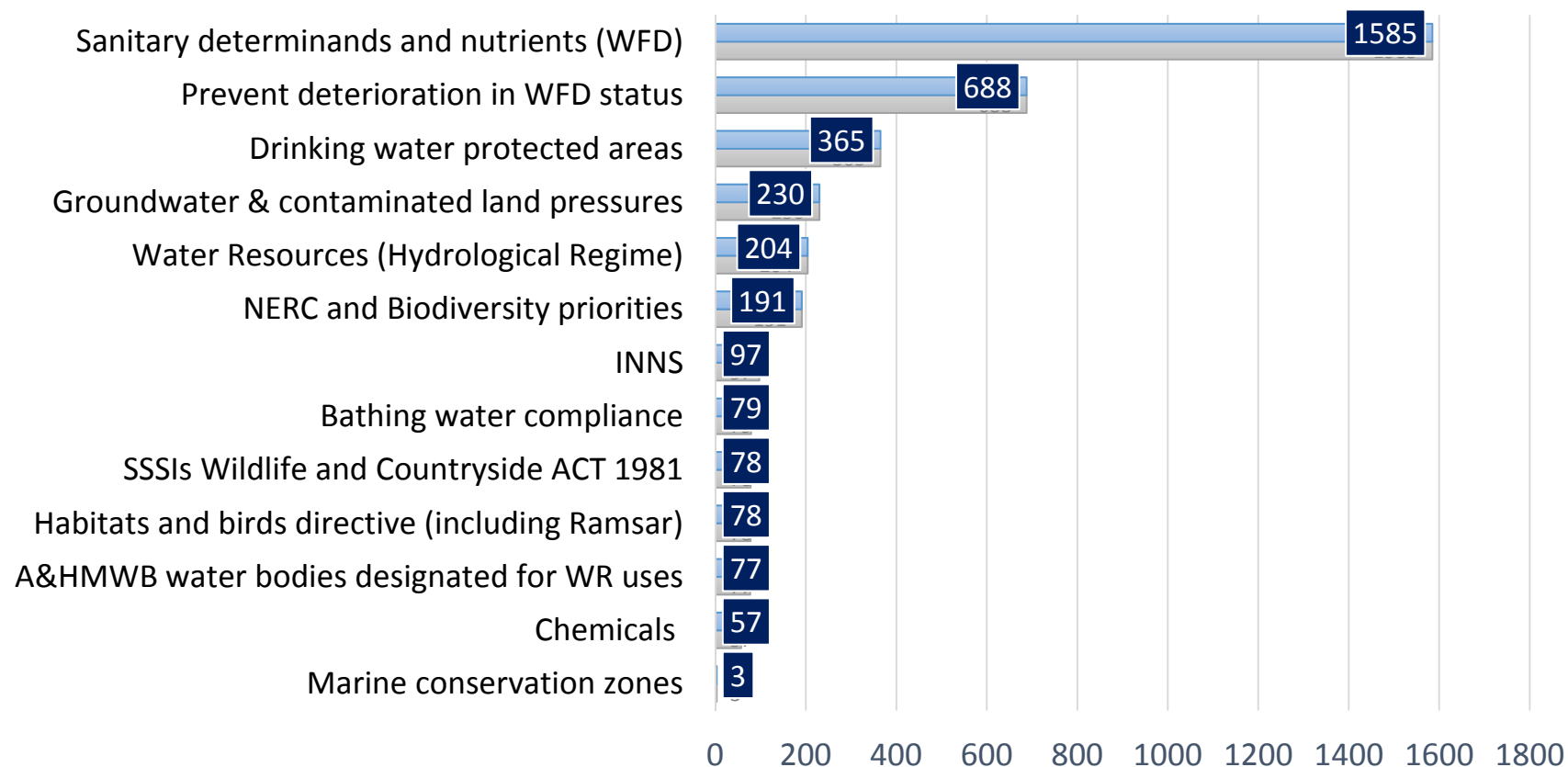
Defra Strategic Policy Statement

- Government (Defra) advice to Ofwat for PR19. Focuses on two priorities:
 - Securing long term resilience
 - Protecting customers

*WINEP2 will be formally released on 30 September 2017. WINEP3 on the 30 March 2018. Work to identify sustainable and cost effective ways of achieving WINEP and WISER outcomes should be an on-going process and not end with the submission of business plans.
